The main attractions of the city



The Kadriorg Park. *An excellent place, boasting a 300-year-long history, which occupies more than 70 hectares. The territory today is very well kept, and the beautiful park corners are suitably accompanied with the splendid landscaping where flowers and nicely trimmed bushes alternate with the evergreen lawns.*



Alexander Nevsky Cathedral. *The splendour and power of this building entice people and they always tend to come here. The cathedral was built in 1887 keeping with the best traditions of Russian architecture.*



Oleviste Church. The church was built as a tower which is now 124 metres high. There is a scenic viewpoint for the tourists, overlooking the spectacular view of the entire city, including its medieval part. The ascent is 232 steps but the view is absolutely worth ascending.



The Town Hall Pharmacy. According to the papers, the building was erected in the 15 century and considered to be one of the oldest in Europe. The building today houses a museum where you can see various relics and medieval pharmacy attributes. The tourists may also buy souvenirs, choosing from a broad range of items.
